
## **Atlantic Sharpnose Shark**

Rhizoprionodon terraenovae



RANGE: Gulfwide. A very similar species, the Caribbean Sharpnose, Rhizoprionodon porosus, is found along with this one in the Straits of Florida and off Yucatan.

**HABITAT:** Coastal, including surf, shallow flats and streams, often in schools.

**DESCRIPTION:** The snout is longer than the mouth is wide. Color is brown or dark gray above; white below. Dorsal and caudal fins are edged in black.

**SIZE:** Averages 2 feet; maximum about 4 feet. World record 16 pounds.

FOOD VALUE: Very good.

**GAME QUALITIES:** Energetic and strong on light tackle.

**TACKLE AND BAITS:** Light spinning and baitcasting tackle with wire leaders and small live or dead baitfish, or cutbaits.

FISHING SYSTEMS: Still Fishing; Drifting.
