

DESCRIPTION: Because of the black-tipped fins, many anglers think the Spinner and Blacktip are the same, but they are different species. Overall coloration is similar, but the Spinner is more slender.

SIZE: Common from 10 pounds. World record 190 pounds.

FOOD VALUE: Very good.

GAME QUALITIES: Often makes high, spinning jumps.

TACKLE AND BAITS: Medium to heavy spinning tackle and light ocean gear. Cutbaits work pretty well.

FISHING SYSTEMS: Casting; Drifting; Still Fishing.

OTHER NAMES:

Large Blacktip Shark

RANGE: Gulfwide, More common in warm seasons.

HABITAT: Ranges almost anywhere, from the open Gulf to beaches and passes, in search of Mackerel and other schooling fish on which it mostly feeds.
